Aromas of ripe figs, red cherry fruit and marmalade with sweet integrated tannins having a fine balance between fruit and wood with a long, fresh and persistent finish.	
27. Lauca Reserve Carignan. Chile	£25.00
Deep, dark red with aromas of liquorice and treacle and aromatic Pyrenean herbs, the palate has more than a nod to southern France with powerful intense flavours, gutsy tannins and bags of character.	
28. Don David Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva. Argentina	£26.00
Intense red colour with concentration on the nose of dark fruits such as blackberries and cassis being juicy and fruity on the palate. Full bodied with silky tannins, enjoy with meats and strong cheese.	
29. Lirac Domaine Des Cigalounes. France	£27.00
Attractive deep red. Aromatic and smooth with notes of fruit and spices. A soft and full wine with an extremely silky-textured finish. Forget Chateauneuf, Lirac is the new popes wine!	
30. Bonterra Organic Zinfandel. USA	£28.00
Aromas of blueberries and black stone fruits accented with black pepper, spicy and toasty palate lead to an elegant, balanced and soft finish.	
31. Chateau Roc De Bernon Puisseguin St Emilion. France	£28.00
Full flavoured, yet with a soft, fruity finish together with a clean palate and great length.	
32. Gigondas Domaine St Damien. France	£39.00
This is a powerful wine showing sweet fruit, prunes and hints of pepper with a smooth texture; fine fruit and structure with a lovely length. From the appellation next to Chateauneuf du Pape.
